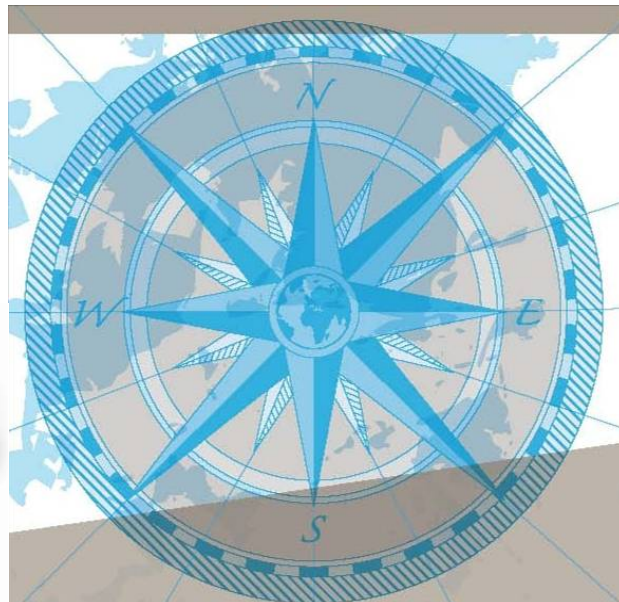
## World Tools Collection – the best garden tool designs from around the world

**Japanese RAZOR Hoe** – this sharp, angled hoe is drawn through soil towards the gardener – effectively cultivating the soil and chopping / removing all weeds in its path. RRP £8.95

**Japanese Mighty Hand Pick** – break into hard ground without breaking your wrist. The sharp point and weighted head make small scale tilling of baked, root bound or stony ground, almost effortless. RRP £11.95

**Eastern Sickle** – The tough serrated blade is ideal for biting into and cleanly cutting fibrous material such as phormium strops. RRP £7.95

**North American Angled Weeding Knife** – a unique multi functional tool which pulls really tough weeds out by engaging its barbs with roots, levers short rooted weeds out with its v-shaped notch and pulls weeds from between paving stones with its pointed tip. RRP £16.95

**American Soil & Potting scoops** – acting as an extension to the hand, these ingenious digging tools allow far tighter holes to be dug than is possible with a standard trowel. RRP £15.95 - £16.95
